Sunday 26th February: "The 50 in 4"

50 miles of a hilly course taking in Seisdon, Shipley, Bridgnorth, Morville, Much Wenlock, Wenlock Edge, Longville, Morville, Bridgnorth, Tinkers Castle, Seisdon & Ebstree

Sunday 4th March: "The Wrekin Wrun"

An even hillier and more testing course of 55 miles around Seisdon, Tinkers Castle, Sutton Maddock, Coalport, Ironbridge, 'Darby Road', Little Wenlock, Eaton Constantine, Cressage, Hughley, 'Five Chimneys', Presthope, Much Wenlock, Barrow, Coalport, Ryton, Patshull, Rudge Heath, Upper Ludstone, Tinkers Castle, Seisdon & Ebstree.
